- BETWEEN JULY AND DECEMBER 2021 805 NIGERIAN MEDICAL DOCTORS REGISTERED IN THE UK GMC
- OVER 8178 NIG DOCTORS IN THE UK
- MARCH 2021 OVER 15049 NURSES NIG IN THE UK.
